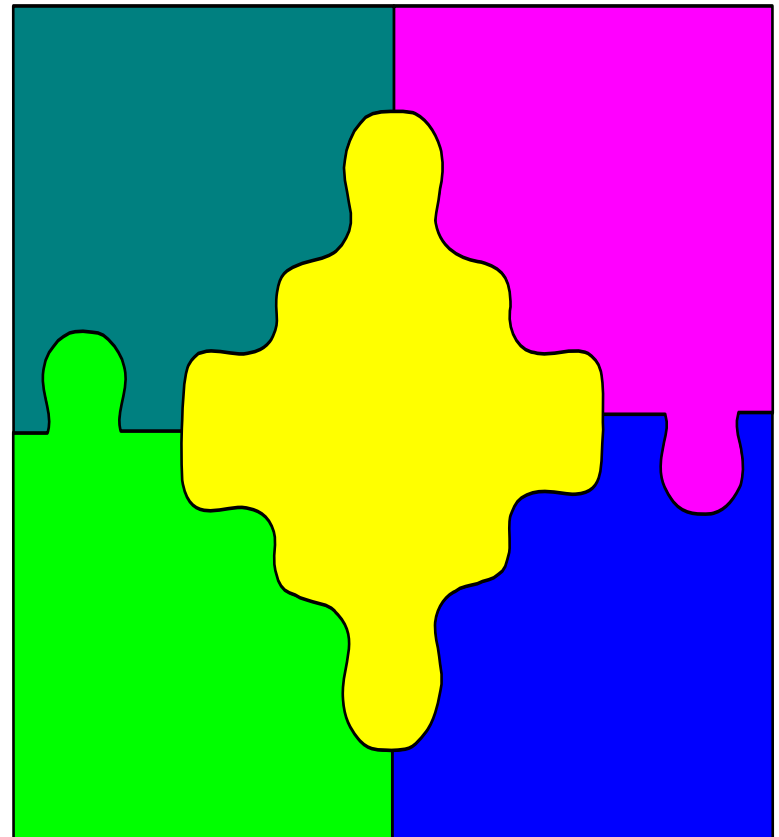


# The College Selection Process: Putting all the Pieces Together!

# *How to be a “Survivor” in College*
